The purpose of this meeting is for correcting clerical errors, mutual mistakes of fact and qualified errors. The July Board of Review also has the authority to grant principal residence exemptions, disabled veterans' exemptions and poverty exemptions. The owner of property for which a principal residence exemption has been rescinded may appeal that rescission to the July Board of Review. An owner who owned and occupied a principal residence on June 1 of 2019, or June 30 of 2020 or June 1 of 2021 or 2022 may appeal to the July Board of Review if the exemption was not on that year's tax roll.

Qualified Disabled Veterans or their surviving spouses may file for an exemption on the 2022 tax bills for the property that they own and occupy as their homestead. Affidavits must be filed with the assessor by July 19th.

Property owners may apply for a poverty exemption on their principal residence if they have not already applied for the poverty exemption during the 2022 calendar year. A completed application for consideration of a poverty exemption must be submitted to the Assessor prior to July 19th. Application forms may be picked up from the assessor's office.
